COMPETITION VENUE

The MGA, officially opened in April 2014, has turned out to be a favourite competition and training venue of gymnasts from different corners of the world. This gymnastics specialized Arena has already hosted the 30th Rhythmic Gymnastics European Championships (June 13-15, 2014), the 1st WTF World Cadet Taekwondo Championships (July 24-27, 2014), as well as 2015 NN Table Tennis Club ITTF-Europe Top 16 CUP" (February 6-8), Open Joint Azerbaijan Championships in Gymnastics Disciplines (held as a Test Event for the 1st European Games, March 4-6, 2015), Competitions in 6 Gymnastics Disciplines of the 1st European Games (June 14-21, 2015), the FIG Artistic Gymnastics World Challenge Cup AGF Trophy (February 19-21, 2016), the FIG Trampoline Gymnastics World Cup AGF Trophy (March 5 & 6, 2016), the FIG Rhythmic Gymnastics World Cup AGF Trophy (July 22-24, 2016), Opening Ceremony of the 42nd Chess Olympiad (September 1, 2016), the FIG Trampoline Gymnastics and Tumbling World Cup AGF Trophy (February 18 & 19, 2017), the FIG Artistic Gymnastics Individual Apparatus World Cup (March 16-19, 2017).

The Arena has the ability to stretch from 5,000 to 9,600 seats, depending on the size and the nature of the event it hosts.

	There will be held Qualifications and Finals in accordance with the FIG Technical Regulations 2017 and the Rules for the FIG World Cup Competitions and Series in Rhythmic Gymnastics.
COMPETITION	The All-Around will also be a qualification for the Apparatus Finals.
FORMAT	The format of the competition is as follows:
	 Competition for Individual All-Around/Qualification (for Apparatus Finals) and Apparatus Finals
	 Competition for Groups All-Around/Qualification (for Apparatus Finals) and Group routines (Final - 5 / 3+2)
COMPETITION	The lighting at the whole competition hall will be turned down. The light will be directed on RG Floor as it was last year. In this regard, the FIG Technical Regulations' requirements will be respected.
HALL	The podium trainings prior to the Qualification days will be organized with the same lighting conditions.
AGF TROPHY	There will be held awarding of the AGF Trophy Cup to one individual gymnast and one group who have the highest execution result at the Qualification/All-Around during the event.
	Opening Ceremony
	The Opening Ceremony will take place at MGA, at 16:30 on April 28, 2016. The participants are not required to take part in the Ceremony.
CEREMONIES	Award Ceremonies The award ceremonies will be held as per the detailed competition schedule and carried out in accordance with the FIG Regulations for Award Ceremonies. Please ensure that your Federation's medalists are in time for the line-up prior to the ceremonies. The competitors requested to attend the award ceremonies will be as follows: Gymnasts ranked 1 st to 3 rd on each apparatus. Gymnasts will be required to wear the correct competition attire. The national flags of the countries represented by the best 3 gymnasts will be
	hoisted and the national anthem of the country taken the 1 st place will be







played. AGF Trophy will be presented to athletes received highest execution score by the LOC. Prize Money The Organizing Committee will transfer the Prize Money to the bank account of the countries' concerned in accordance with Article 10 of the Rules for the FIG Rhythmic Gymnastics World Cup series after the competitions. The LOC will provide first aid medical services. Physiotherapists will be present during the competitions. The Organizing Member Federation will provide at its own charge a minimum of 4 doping controls for Individual gymnasts and 4 for Groups. Appropriate medical premises will be provided to carry out a minimum required number of doping controls by ANADA (National Anti-Doping Agency).
